### Quantum of black money

\*32. SHRI RAM NARESH KUSHAWAHA: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) what is the estimated percentage of rise in the black money during the year 1983-84 as compared to the rise in the percentage of black money during the years 1981-82 and 1982-83; and

(b) what steps have been taken by Government to unearth black money and its growth and what are the details of the results achieved?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI S. M. KRISHNA): (a) The Government have not made any assessment with regard to rise in the percentage of black money during 1983-84 as compared to earlier years.

(b) All possible measures to check circulation and prevent further proliferation of Black Money, including administrative, legislative and institutional are being taken from time to time.

*Prima facie* unaccounted assets valued at Rs. 27.99 crores approximately were seized in course of searches conducted by Income-tax Department during 1983-84. As a result of survey operations, 63,559 new income tax assesseees were added during the period 1-4-83 to 31-12-83. The proposals for launching prosecution for concealment of income/wealth have been approved in 878 cases in 1983-84.
