Benzoate at prices lower than Govtrnment notified prices. The prices notified by the Government for these two drugs are the maximum sale prices and ihe manufacturers are free to sell at any price not exceeding the maximum price fixed by the Government. (b) The price allowed for Metronidazole in the formulations is Rs. 497.98 per kg. and for Metronidazole Benzoate it is Rs, 600/- per kg. Information regarding quantity of the two drugs obtain ed by tte major formulators from different sources is being collected and the extent of unintended profit, if any, would be known after the details are received.

(b) and W) was observed in 1981-82 that the increasing import of Doxycycline was adversely affecting the indigenous production of this bulk drug. Immediate steps were taken to restrict import of Doxycycline and its intermediates. The entry in Appendix 9 (List of Canalised drugs) of the Import Policy for 1982-83 was amended to include Doxycycline m-'ermediates. No canalised import of Doxycycline was resorted to in 1983-84.
