THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI NAMO NARAIN MEENA):

(a) to (c) The Union Finance Minister in the pre-Budget meeting with the Finance Ministers of States and Union Territories, on 13 January, 2010 emphasised that there was enough wheat and rice stocks and highlighted the need to address the problem of distribution to arrest the price rise in food items. He requested the state Governments to cooperate in this regard to lift surplus stocks allotted to them and highlighted the need to strengthen the public distribution system in the country. Against an allocation of 1 million tonnes of rice to States/Union Territories for distribution to retail consumers under Open Market Sale Scheme (Domestic), the lifting as on
