

- (c) the total cost of projects; and
- (d) if there is any delay in completion, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL):
 (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c) Construction of new international terminal building at Varanasi airport has been taken up at a cost of Rs. 129.38 crores and is expected to be completed by March, 2010. Construction of new integrated terminal building including aerobridge at Lucknow airport has been taken up at a cost of Rs. 94.11 crores and is expected to be completed by July, 2010.

(d) At Lucknow airport, the work was delayed initially due to disturbance by villagers and revised site of the terminal building and subsequently due to inadequate/poor resource mobilization by the work awarded Agency. At Varanasi airport, the initial delay was due to relocation of site of new terminal building, service and revision of drawings.

Vacancy in NACIL

12. SHRI AMBETH RAJAN: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state how many vacancies for the post of Trainee Engineers/Executive Engineers are existing so far for SC/ST/OBC categories in National Aviation Company of India Ltd. (NACIL)(I) and NACIL(A)?

 Consequent to amalgamation of erstwhile Indian Airlines Limited and erstwhile Air India Limited into the National Aviation Company of India Limited in August, 2007, recruitment processes were kept in abeyance in view of restructuring and integration of manpower. Subsequently, recruitment for all posts has been kept on hold till the reassessment of manpower in all Departments of the merged entity is carried out.
