Condition of testing facilities at AIIMS

97. SHRI SANJAY RAUT:

SHRI GOVINDRAO WAMANRAO ADIK:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the patients coming from various parts of the country in general and particularly those suffering from fatal diseases are not getting proper treatment in All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS);

- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether patients have to get the tests done from outside as various types of testing equipment are out of order in AIIMS; and
- (d) if so, the action plan formulated by Government to overcome these shortcomings?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD): (a) to (d) Patients visiting All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi from all over the country are attended to in various specialty/super-specialty Out Patient Departments (OPDs) as per maximum handling capacity or in the casualty, if the condition of patient requires so. Patients needing inpatient hospitalization are admitted subject to availability of bed. There is a system of having 10 years' maintenance contract with the firms at the time of equipment purchase and hence the equipments are functional. Laboratory, radio diagnostic and other investigations required for the patients, which are available, are done in various laboratories as per maximum handling capacity. Due priority is given to inpatients and emergency patients. However, since the number of OPD patients is very large, they have to either wait for the required investigations or may have to get tests done from outside.

Exodus of senior doctors from AIIMS

98. SHRI D. RAJA: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that a number of senior doctors have left the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) recently to work in private hospitals in Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details of the doctors who left AIIMS during the last one year; and
- (c) what are the reasons therefor and what remedial measures are being taken to check the exodus of the senior doctors from AIIMS?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD): (a) to (c) During the last one year, seven faculty members against the total sanctioned strength of 629 faculty which comes to 1.11% have either resigned/or taken voluntary retirement from the service of the AIIMS **"on personal grounds"**. The details of faculty members who have resigned/took voluntary retirement during the last one year are given in the Statement (See below).

The pay scales of faculty have recently been revised consequent upon implementation of 6th Central Pay Commission recommendation. The orders regarding revision of pay scales have been issued on 12.01.2010.
