

### Inclusion of Kota and Bundi in Rajasthan in the Tourist Circuit

\*139. SHRI BHUVNESH CHATURVEDI: Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to include Kota and Bundi in Rajasthan in the tourist circuit;

(b) whether Government are aware of the rich potential of Kota and Bundi in regard to tourism; and

(c) whether Government would consider to send a team to identify such places in Kota-Bundi region of Rajasthan?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI KHURSHED ALAM KHAN): (a) to (c) Kota and Bundi are not included in the three travel circuits identified by the Department in consultation with the State Government for the development of tourism infrastructure in the State of Rajasthan.

THE MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI PRANAB KUMAR MUKHERJEE): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c) The World Bank has appraised (i) Dudhichua Coal Project and (ii) Jharia Block-II Open Cast Coal Project for a likely assistance of about US \$ 225 million.

### Amount received from IMF

815. SHRI DIPEN GHOSH: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state whether Government will give an account as to how they have spent Rs. 4,000 crores (SDR 3.7 million) received from the IMF?

THE MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI PRANAB KUMAR MUKHERJEE): India has purchased SDR 3.7 billion under the Extended Arrangement with the International Monetary Fund to support the medium term structural adjustment programme. This is not a project tied assistance.
