THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI VIJAY N. PATIL): (a) to (d) Postal Research Centres have been set up by the Central Government, at some places in India since 1952. These Centres, manned by trained Central Government Personnel, essentially keep a watch on foreign mail with a view to detecting Postal and other irregularities/violations. Part of the facilities is provided by the P&T Department.
