

लयों के अहातों में रक्षात्मक उपायों को मजबूत बनाने के लिए कहा है। शाखा में सशस्त्र गार्ड, अलार्म व्यवस्था, टाइम लॉक अथवा इनमें से एक या दो और अन्य रक्षात्मक उपायों के चुनने का काम बैंकों पर छोड़ दिया गया है जो किसी शाखा के स्थान और उसकी भेद्यता को ध्यान में रख कर किया जाता है। अतः बैंकों ने अपने अपने कार्यालयों में रक्षा के वर्तमान उपायों को क्रमबद्ध तरीके से मजबूत करने का काम शुरू कर दिया है जिसमें सशस्त्र गार्डों की तैनाती भी शामिल है। राष्ट्रीयकृत बैंकों की अधिकतर ग्रामीण शाखाओं में फिलहाल सशस्त्र गार्ड नहीं हैं।

बैंक निर्धारित विशेष विवरणों के अनुसार अपनी शाखाओं में कैश सेफों करेंसी चेस्टों/ सुरक्षित कमरों की व्यवस्था करते हैं। इन शाखाओं की संख्या के बारे में सूचना तत्काल उपलब्ध नहीं है जिनमें आर० सी० सी० कैश वाल्ट नहीं हैं।

#### **J&K representatives in the Tourism Advisory Board**

\*231. SHRI GULAM MOHI-UD-DIN SHAWL: Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to refer to the answer to Starred Question 49 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 28th February, 1984 and state:

(a) whether in view of the fact that Tourism is the main industry in the State of Jammu and Kashmir any one from the J&K Tourism Development Corporation, Tourism Department, Hotel Associations or Travel Agencies have been included in the Tourism Advisory Board which was constituted recently; and

(b) if not, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI KHUR-SHEED ALAM KHAN): (a) and (b) The Tourism Advisory Board is a National level body. Its constitution is not on regional basis. The Federation of Hotels and Restaurants Association of India and Travel Agents Association of India are represented on the Board.

#### **Promotion of India exports through non-resident Indians**

(a) whether it is a fact that the non-resident Indians in foreign countries are being asked to boost the export of Indian goods in those countries;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof; and

(c) to what extent our exports would be stepped up as a result thereof?

THE MINISTER OF COMMERCE AND SUPPLY (SHRI VISHWANATH PRATAP SINGH): (a) At present, there is no scheme under which non-resident Indians in foreign countries are being asked to boost the exports of Indian goods in those countries.
