encouraging trekkingj mountanieering during
the years 1981-82, 1982-83 and 1983-84 is

(b) Under the scheme of 'Promotion of
Adventure' being implemented by the
Government, groups of individuals, edu-
cational institutions, voluntary agencies and
Nehru Yuvak Kendras sponsored by the State
Governments|U.T. Administrations! District
Collectors|educational insti-tutions|recognised
organisations in mountaineering, as the case
may be, can be sanctioned grant @ 90 per cent
of the total expenditure on purchase of equip-
ment. No recommendation is necessary in the
case of universities and instituions established
by Central Government|State
GovernmentsjUnion Territory Administra-
tions.
