

Manufacture of ice cream by Government Dairies

SHRI DINESH GOSWAMI:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware that ice cream worth lakhs of rupees is consumed every month in public undertakings like Indian Airlines, Air India, I.T.D.C. hotels and Railways;

(b) whether it is a fact that DMS Mother Dairy have great potential to manufacture superior quality ice cream;

(c) whether Government propose to manufacture ice cream in public sector to prevent the money from going to private sector;

(d) if so, by when; and

(e) if the answer to part (c) above be in the negative, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) At present Delhi Milk Scheme and Mother Dairy, Delhi do not have any facility for the manufacture of ice cream.

(c) to (e) The manufacture of ice cream is reserved for small scale sector.

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SPORTS (SHRI ASHOK GEHLOT): (a) A statement indicating the names of institutions/organisations to which grants were sanctioned by the Government only for purchase of equipment for encouraging trekking/mountaineering during the years 1981-82, 1982-83 and 1983-84 is attached. (See below).

(b) Under the scheme of 'Promotion of Adventure' being implemented by the Government, groups of individuals, educational institutions, voluntary agencies and Nehru Yuvak Kendras sponsored by the State Governments/U.T. Administrations/District Collectors/educational institutions/recognised organisations in mountaineering, as the case may be, can be sanctioned grant @ 90 per cent of the total expenditure on purchase of equipment. No recommendation is necessary in the case of universities and institutions established by Central Government/State Governments/Union Territory Administrations.
