THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY SHIPPING OF TRANSPORT (SHRI Z. R. ANSARI): (a) Yes, Sir. It is a fact that according to the Road User Cost Study-a Research Project conducted by the Central Road Research Institute, considerable savings in fuel consumption and cost of operation of vehicles can be brought about by improving the geometries of roads, widening the pavements and improvements in the riding quality of roads. The exact amount of savings has, however, not been quantified in the Report.

It is a fact that about 25,000 persons are killed in road accidents every year in the country which gives a very high accident rate for the country as compared to other developed countries in the world.
