Jagannath Temple in Puri Orissa

2763. SHRI B. C. PATTANAYAK: Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND CULTURE be pleased to state :

(a) whether greater emphasis has been given by Government for the proper preservation and maintenance of centrally protected monuments in different States;

(b) if so, what steps have been taken by Government for the proper preservation of Jagannath temple at Puri in Orissa; and

(c) what are the details of the work done during 1983-84 in this regard?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRIES OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI P. K. THUNGON): (a) The Centrally protected monuments are preserved and maintained as per their actual needs and the available resources with the Archaeological Survey of India.

(b) and (c) The following conservation works at the Jagannath temple, Puri are in progress since 1975 as per the recommendations of an Expert Committee: deplastering and repair works have been restricted on the external face of the *garbhagriha* up to the springing level of the

spire; the damaged carved stones are being joined together with epoxy resin, duly strengthened by inserting non-corrosive metal pins; sea-salt lodged in the masonry is being drawn out; the disturbed masonry is being stabilized with grouting, pointing and replacement of damaged stones wherever necessary; and a preservative coat on the repaired and treated surface of walls is being applied.

Declaring Nepal a Zone of Peace

2764. SHRI RAMKRISHNA MAZUMDER: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state what is the reaction of Government of India on the proposal of the Government of Nepal to declare Nepal zone of peace?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI P. V. NARASIMHA RAO): The Government of India are already committed to "peace and friendship" with Nepal in the Indo-Nepal Treaty of Peace and Friendship signed on 31st July, 1950 which is valid in perpetuity.
