(a) whether it is a fact that some ticket Collectors have been appointed at Sealdah and Howrah Stations on the Eastern Railway neither through Railway Service Commission nor through Employment Exchange: and

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor?

Railway accidents

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) what is the number of Railway accidents and dacoities that occurred from 1st January, 1983 to 31st October, 1983 and what are the reasons for each of those accidents;

(b) the total number of passengers killed and injured in the said accidents;

(c) what steps Government have taken in this regard; and

(d) whether any of the said accidents took place due to sabotage?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI A. B. A. GHANI KHAN CHAUDHURI): (a) During January to October, 1983, 616 train accidents

and 86 dacoities (upto September) took place on Indian Railways. These accidents were due to failure of railway staff, failure of persons other than railway staff, failure of equipment, sabotage and combination of track and rolling stock defects, etc.

(b) The number of passengers killed and injured in these accidents is as under:—

Killed	47
Injured	383

(c) 11 accidents have been attributed to sabotage/suspected sabotage.

(d) Some of the anti sabotage measures are:—

(i) Patrolling of track by engineering gangmen, village defence parties and home guards, and Police on vulnerable sections.

(ii) Guarding of vulnerable bridges.

(iii) Running of pilot or patrol special or Goods trains ahead of a passenger train when trouble on a section is specially apprehended.

(iv) Burring of fishbolts where-by after the nuts are tightened on the bolt, the threads are destroyed and the bolt cannot be removed without using a chisel.

(v) Reducing the number of fish-plated joints by welding of joints which also improves riding quality.

Suburban trains in Sealdah division

169. SHRI NEPALDEV BHATTACHARJEE: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that all suburban trains of Sealdah Division in Eastern Railway ran record late in the last eight months of 1983; and

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI A. B. A. GHANI KHAN CHAUDHURI): (a) and (b) No. However, the punctuality performance of suburban trains of Sealdah Division has not been very satisfactory during last 8 months of 1983 mainly due to Signal and Telecommunication failure, unit failure, Over Head Equipment trouble/failure, accidents and repercussion thereof and miscreant activities etc.

(b) whether the office of DRM Allahabad has since prepared a statement of payments to be made to the concerned employees and whether payments been made to each one of them, if so, on what dates and, if not, the reasons therefor; and

(c) what are the dues to be paid to these retired persons relating to National Holiday Allowance, life Insurance deductions, reimbursement of tuition fees & ADA II and by when they are likely to be paid?
