The Delhi Development Authority liave taken up work for revising the Master Plan for Delhi with a new perspective covering the period 1981—2001. This revision is at an advanced stage. However, it is not feasible to indicate the' • exact titne by which it would be finalised.

(i) to cater to the urban poor and other groups with adequate infrastructure, housing and transport.

(ii) economic development through physical development, by way of channelising the growth of activities such as industry, commerce, distribution and services.
