

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI MOHAMMED USMAN ARIF): (a) and (b). The Delhi Development Authority have taken up work for revising the Master Plan for Delhi with a new perspective covering the period 1981—2001. This revision is at an advanced stage. However, it is not feasible to indicate the exact time by which it would be finalised.

(c) The basic objectives identified by the DDA for the purpose of revision are:—

(i) to cater to the urban poor and other groups with adequate infrastructure, housing and transport.

(ii) economic development through physical development, by way of channelising the growth of activities such as industry, commerce, distribution and services.

(iii) fitting image of the city as Capital of the country.

Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes PGT and TGT in Central Schools

502. SHRI PANDURANG DHARMAJI JADHAV: Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) what is the number of Central Schools in India;

(b) what is the number of TGTs and PGTs and out of them what is the number of SC/ST as PGTs and TGTs separately;

(c) whether there is a backlog of vacancies reserved for the SC PGTs and ST PGTs in the Kendriya Vidyalayas; and

(d) if so, by when the backlog of vacancies reserved for SC/ST, TGTs and PGTs will be cleared?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRIES OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI P. K. THUNGON): (a) 447.

(b) As on 30-4-1983, there were 4139 TGTs and 2244 PGTs in Kendriya Vidyalayas. Out of them, 70 TGTs and 26 PGTs belonged to SC/ST communities.

(c) Yes, Sir.

(d) All efforts are being made to clear the backlog as soon as possible. However, it is not possible to indicate any definite time limit as it would depend upon the availability of suitable candidates.
