(a) whether it is a fact that the IISCO,

Kulti, has been overburdened with high paid officers since its take over by Government whereas the number of workers has sharply reduced;

(b) whether it is a fact that there is large scale thefts of pig iron meant for the factory en-route and from the yard of the factory; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI N. K. P. SALVE): (a) No. Sir. The reduction in the strength of workers since the take over by the Government is 11 per cent but the reduction in the case of senior officers (Chief Supreintendents and above) is 37 per cent.

- (b) No theft of pig iron meant for Kulti Works has been reported.
- (c) Kulti uses coke produced from coal raised in its captive colliery. No complaint regarding the supply of substandard raw materials has been received.

Training in Entrepreneurship for North-East region

3221. SHRI ROBIN KAKATI: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a proposal under Government's consideration to train enterpreneurs for North-Eastern region; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if the answer to part (a) above be in the negative, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI S. M. KRISHNA): (a) and (b) There are already many programmes for training entrepreneurs in the North-Eastern Region conducted by different agencies. include training of various categories of entrepreneurs such as unemployed engineers, women, weaker sections, students, rural artisans educated unemployed and physically handicapped persons etc. duration of training ranges from one to months. In some programmes stipend ranging between Rs. 100/- to Rs. 250/- is also available depending upon the category of trainees.

Staff Unions in Geological Survey of India

3222. SHRI SURAJ PRASAD: Will the Minister of STEEL AND MINES be pleased to state:

(a) what are the reasons that the ad hoc

recognition granted to the Geological Survey of India Staff Union without eligibility for Joint Consultative Machinery facilities has not been reviewed after two years in accordance with the terms of recognition;

- (b) whether his Ministry propose to carry out membership verification of the Geological Survey of India Staff Union to justify continuation of ad hoc recognition;
- (c) if so, whether verification of other unions operating in the Geological Survey of India would also be subjected to membership verification, if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the geological Survey of India Staff Union is affiliated to West Bengal unit of Indian National Trade Union Congress; and
- (e) if so, the rules under which Government unions in Central Government offices can be affiliated to Central Trade Unions?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI N. K. P. SALVE): (a) to (c) The terms and conditions under which recognition was granted to G.S.I. Staff Union for purposes other than J.C.M. do not stipulate any review. As the rules/regulations for recognition of Service Associations are being drafted by a group set up under National Council of Joint Consultative Machinery, the question of verificatios of memberships of various Service Associations in Geological Survey of India cannot be token up at this stage.

(d) and (e) It is seen that the G.S.I. Staff Union has printed on its letter head the words "Affiliated to I.N.T.U.C." This Department does not have any other information about the affiliation.
