

and other equipment. It was also agreed to depute to India two Soviet seismic teams with equipment to carry out seismic surveys in Cambay (onshore) and West Bengal. It was further agreed to examine the possibility of increasing the number of such Soviet seismic teams to five.

It was also agreed that the Soviet side would depute four additional Soviet workover teams with the requisite workover equipment to increase the repair of sick wells in Gujarat. Training in prevention of blow-outs and fires for 10—12 Indian specialists in the USSR was also agreed to.

The Soviet side also agreed to examine the request of the Indian side for providing specialised geoscientific equipment also to study the possibility of undertaking this specialised work in India with Soviet personnel. The possibility of training Indian drillers in the USSR in batches was also agreed.

The setting up of a working group for cooperation in oil exploration and production within the frame work of the Inter-Governmental Indian-Soviet commission on the economic scientific and technical cooperation was also agreed to be recommended for the consideration of the said Commission.

(a) whether Government are aware that in most of the underground coal mine; under various companies of Coal India Ltd., large scale contract labour is being employed and a number of diem have been killed in accidents and deprived of compensation by the contractors and managements;

(b) what are the names of mines where contract labour is still employed for various underground jobs and the present number of men—colliery-wise and company-wise;

(c) the nature of jobs undertaken by them;

(d) the total payment made to contractors for these works, company-wise in 1980, 1981, 1982 and 1983;

(e) why no steps have been taken to departmentalise them and prohibit employment of contract labour underground; and

(f) in how many mines contract labourers lost their lives in accidents, company-wise and colliery-wise and amount of compensation paid in each case during 1980, 1981, 1982 and so far in 1983?
