Agitation of Central Bank Employees

784. SHRI SYED AZEEZ PASHA: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware about the agitation of Central Bank Employees for the Past 25 days over certain grievances;

(b) whether the bilateral practice has been given up, if so, the reasons therefor;

(c) the reasons for violating bipartite agreement between employees and management; and

(d) the concrete steps for redressal of employees grievances?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI PAWAN KUMAR BANSAL): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) to (d) The Central Bank of India has reported that even during the currency of employee's formal and informal discussions have been held with the employees unions and there has been no violation of bipartite agreement entered into with the majority union for award staff. The management of the bank has already indicated its readiness to have further rounds of discussions to sort out the issues through bilateral forum.
