योजना मंत्री (श्री एस० बी० जवाहरलाल नेहरू) : (क) छठी योजना का मूल्यांकन लगभग पूरा हो गया है ।

(ख) मूल्यांकन की एक प्रति श्रीमन्त्री ही सदन के सभा पटल पर प्रस्तुत कर दी जाएगी ।

Paper Mills in the Country

*274. SHRIMATI ILA BHATTACHARYA: Will the Ministry of INDUSTRY be pleased to state;

(a) what is the number of paper mills in the country at present;

(b) whether it is a fact that Government propose to set up one paper mill in Tripura; and

(c) if so, by when this proposal is likely to be implemented?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI S. M. KRISHNA): (a) As on 1st January, 1983 there were 177 units in the organised sector manufacturing paper and papers board.

(b) and (c) The Government of Tripura have proposed the setting up of a paper/ pulp mill based on the bamboo resources of the State. It is, however, necessary that adequate infrastructural facilities are developed to support a major project like a paper mill. As the existing infrastruc-

ture is inadequate, there is no proposal to take up the project in the current plan.

Armed hold-ups and robberies

*275. SHRI SATYA PAL MALIK: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state;

(a) what is the number of armed hold ups and robberies in Delhi during the last six months and what is the number of persons if any, killed in such incidents; and

(b) what is the estimated loss suffered by the victims as a result thereof and what precise steps have been taken by Government to liquidate the gangs responsible for such crimes and to improve the law and order situation in Delhi?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NIHAR RANJAN LASKAR): (a) During the period from 1st January, 1983 to 30th June, 1983, 116 cases of armed holdups and robberies have been reported to the Delhi Police. In one case registered Under sections 397/302 T.P.C. as a murder case at the Police Station Sarai Rohilla, the motive was robbery. There has been no loss of life in other cases.

(b) The estimated loss suffered in these cases is about 27,95,500. As a result of vigorous police investigation, 100 persons responsible for these cases have already been arrested and 21 of them are facing trial in the courts. Property worth Rs. 6.79 lakhs has also been so far recovered.

To check such crimes the Delhi Police has taken various steps like armed patrol-line with walkie-talkie and wireless sets, action against known criminals and bad characters under the various sections of law including National Security Act, surprise checking of vehicles to detect those involved in commission of crime strengthening of surveillance over known criminals, posting of police pickets and holding of inter-district meetings with police officials of adjoining States to ensure coordinated action and proper collection of intelligence regarding criminals.
