## Functioning of flood control Department Delhi

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION (SHRI RAM NIWAS MIRDHA): (a) and (b) The Delhi Administration has reported that percentage of works carried out by Civil Engineering Divisions is per cent and by Mechanical about 20 per cent. Delhi Administration has further reported that with the available machinery and skilled man-power the Department is able to execute only 15 to 20 per cent of the annual earth work through Mechanical Division. The Civil Engineering Divisions deploy thousands of manual labour, donkey labour and camel carts etc. offering employment opportunities to the poor strata of the society. The extensive embankment and drainage works are normally carried manually and mechanised means are generally adopted in some specific and difficult reaches.
