

In the case of appointments covered by the Central Staffing Scheme, the tenure of individual officers could be extended/curtailed in the exigencies of Government work and for administrative considerations in public Interest.

In the case of other deputations from State Governments to Central Government as well as deputations from one Central Department to another Department which are outside the purview of the Central Staffing Scheme, the maximum of deputation is 3 years except for those posts where longer period of tenure is prescribed. However, the administrative Ministries may grant extension beyond the normal period of three years upto one year after obtaining orders of their Secretary in cases where such extension is considered necessary in public interest. Extension beyond this period would be with the specific approval of the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms in the Ministry of Home Affairs.

#### **Licensed/unlicensed industrial units in Karol Bagh Zone, New Delhi**

Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state;

(a) what is the number of licensed/unlicensed factories and Small Scale industrial units working in the colonies of Inder Lok, Anand Nagar and Tulsi Nagar on the Old Rohtak Road in Karol Bagh Zone, Delhi;

(b) whether there is any proposal under Government's consideration to declare the said colonies as industrial areas; and

(c) what steps Government have taken or propose to take to remove

unauthorised factories which have been set-up in residential premises and are causing health hazards for the residents of that area?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI NARAYAN DATT TIWARI): (a) 175 licences have been granted by the Municipal Corporation of Delhi to small scale industrial units in Inder Lok, Anand Nagar and Tulsi Nagar. No statistics are available regarding unauthorised factories.

(b) No, Sir.

(c) A large number of industrial plots have been allotted by all the developing agencies in Delhi for shifting industries from non-conforming areas particularly obnoxious and hazardous industries.
