Recognition to SC/ST Associations

1046. SHRI NATHA SINGH: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to refer to the reply to Unstarred Question 1932 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 17th March, 1983 and state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government have recognised some Welfare Associations Councils etc. of SC/ST communities;

(b) if so, the reasons for recognising them and the precise policy of Government under which these have been recognised; and

(c) the reasons for not recognising All India Federation of SC/ST, Backward and Minority Employees Welfare Association (Regd.), New Delhi?

THE MINISTER

(a) and (b) Government have enlisted some outside voluntary welfare associations of SC/ST only for the purpose of giving wider publicity to the vacancies reserved for SC/ST. If sufficient number of SC/ST candidates are not available through the Employment Exchange, the reserved vacancies are advertised and simultaneously with such advertisements, these vacancies should also be brought to the notice of the listed SC/ST Organisations.
