Setting up of colour film units

265. SHRI B. C. PATTANAYAK:
Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) the number of colour film units which have been set up in the country so far;

(b) whether any decision has been taken as to the number of such units proposed to be set up during the Sixth

(c) if so, the number of such units proposed to be set up during the above plan period; and

(d) the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY
(SHRI NARAYAN DATT TIWARI):

(a) to (d) There is no unit in the country at present engaged in the manufacture of colour film. Hindustan Photo Films Manufacturing Company Limited, a public sector undertaking, which at present, undertakes conversion of imported jumbo rolls, has a proposal to set up integrated production of colour positive film. The investment and locational decision in this regard are yet to be taken.

An application from Navrang Photo Films Private Limited for setting up a 100 per cent Export Oriented unit in District Kolar in the State of Karnataka for the manufacture of Cellulose Triacetate and various types of photo films including colour film, has also been received.

Crime against Harijans

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that crime against Harijans is mounting in some parts of the country;

(b) if so, what is the number of cases of crime which have been registered in different States in the year 1983 so far (month-wise); and

(c) what steps have been taken to protect the lives of Harijans in these States?

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI P. C. SETTY): (a) State-wise figures of crimes against Scheduled Castes for 1981 and 1982 furnished in reply to Unstarred Question No. 464 on 24-2-1983 may be referred to.

(b) A statement showing the number of cases of crimes committed against the Scheduled Castes in the year 1983 (to the extent available), State-wise, based on the information furnished by the State Governments is enclosed.

(c) Comprehensive guidelines covering precautionary, preventive, punitive, rehabilitative and personnel policy measures that are to be taken for checking crimes against Scheduled Castes have been communicated in the Union Home Minister's D.O. letter dated 10th March, 1980, a copy of which has already been laid on the Table of the House in reply to Rajya Sabha Starred Question No. 64 dated 12th June, 1980. Close and continuous touch is maintained with the State Governments regarding effective implementation of these guidelines.
