(b) Powers under section Cr. P. C. vest in the Sub-Divisional Magistrates, District Magistrates and the State Government. According to the State Government in view of the difficult law and order situation competent authorities took recourse to Sec. 144 Cr.P.C. as per the local requirements. However, strict instructions were issued to ensure that operation of Section 144 Cr.P.C. does not interfere with peaceful and legiticampaign including mate election holding of election meetings. The provisions of the Assam Special Powers (Press) Act 1960 were invoked by the State Government for preventing and combating activities affecting the maintenance of communal harmony and public order.
