**Compensation to the victims of road  
accidents in Delhi**

(a) the number of road accidents  
which occurred in Delhi and also the  
number of injured/dead persons as a  
result thereof during the last three  
years and so far in the current year,  
year-wise; and

(b) the number of injured persons  
or the relatives of dead persons who  
have as yet not received compensa-  
tion?

THE MINISTER OF SHIPPING  
AND TRANSPORT (SHRI K.  
VIJAYA BHASKARA REDDY): (a)  
Compensation to the victims of road  
accidents in Delhi Year-wise informa-  
tion is as under:—

(b) Compensation is awarded by  
the Motor Accident Claims Tribunals  
on the basis of Claims lodged.  
According to the information fur-  
nished by Delhi Administration, 3214  
cases of claims for compensation are  
under trial before the Motor Acci-  
dents Claims Tribunals and thus as  
many claimants could be said to have  
as yet to receive compensation.
