

**Release of occupational Industry
survey Reports by DGE&T**

21981. SHRI PANDURANG DHARMAJI JADHAV: Will the Minister of LABOUR AND REHABILITATION be pleased to state:

(a) how many occupational outlook survey reports and Industry survey reports have been prepared and released by the Directorate General of Employment & Training so far;

(b) what are the details of the survey reports released during the last year;

(c) whether any proposal has been made by the Technical Advisory Committee to conduct Live Register survey to ascertain the proportions of job-seekers;

(d) if so, what steps have been taken by Government to start this 'survey- and

(e) if the answer to part (c) above be in the negative, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND REHABILITATION (SHRI DHARMVIR): (a) Ten Occupational Outlook Survey Reports and nine Industry Survey Reports have been prepared and released by the DGE&T so far.

(b) During the last calendar year, i.e., 1982, the following survey reports have been released: —

(i) Report on the Study on Occupational Outlook for Heavy Transport Vehicle Driver.

(ii) Report on the Survey on Employment in Automobile Tyres Industry.

(c) The Sub-Committee appointed by the Technical Committee on Surveys and Research Studies has recommended conducting of Live Register survey, to ascertain the activity status of the job-seekers.

(d) A Plan scheme has already been prepared in this regard, which has been cleared by the Planning Commission.
