- (c) The Sub-Committee appointed by the Technical Committee on Surveys and Research Studies has recommended conducting of Live Register survey, to ascertain the activity status of the job-seekers.
- (d) A Plan scheme has already been prepared in this regard, which has been cleared by the Planning Commission.
