Department of Legal Affairs has opined that judgment of the Supreme Court in the case of E.V. Chinnaiah *vs.* State of Andhra Pradesh & Others is deemed as the final legal position in all respect and its effect can be neutralized only by enacting a valid law.

(b) and (c) After taking into account, the divergent opinions regarding sub-categorisation, the Government has decided that a retired judge of the Supreme Court be appointed to examine the matter in all its aspects.
