

(c) if so, when it was installed and the cost thereof;

(d) what is the result achieved so far and what is the per day capacity; and

(e) whether the Cement Research Institute of India and the Regional Research Laboratory, Jorhat have installed or propose to instal such mini cement plant in other parts of the country and if so, what are the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI VIRBHADRA SINGH): (a) Yes, Sir. Both the Cement Research Institute of India (CRI) and Regional Research Laboratory (RRL) Jorhat have developed mini cement plants based on Vertical Shaft Kiln Technology. While the CRI have developed designs for various capacities such 20, 30, 50, 100 and upto 200 tonne<sub>s</sub> per day, RRL Jorhat ha<sub>s</sub> developed technology for 20 and 35 tonne<sub>s</sub> per day.

(b) to (d) A mini cement plant based on VSK technology of 20 TPD installed by the Tamil Nadu Government in 1962 was handed over to CRI in 1974 (book value of assets Rs. 10.08 lakhs) to carry out research and development work. After taking over, CRI has redesigned and restructured the whole unit to produce Ordinary Portland Cement conforming to ISI Specification and the plant is reportedly working satisfactorily.

(e) No, Sir. However, some mini cement plants based on ' 'the technology developed by these institutes are coming up in different parts of the country.

(c) India and France signed an Agreement on 26th NoveTnber, 1982 wherein Franc<sub>e</sub> agree^ to supply the enriched Uranium needs of the Tarapur Atomic Power Station, in lieu of th<sub>e</sub> US, and within- the framework of the 1963 Co-operation Agreement between India and US on the subject,

A commercial contract t° enable supply has just been concluded on 21st March, 1983, th<sub>e</sub> two Governments having accorded their approvals to the contents of the draft contract initialled earlier. With this French supplie<sub>s</sub> ar<sub>e</sub> expected to commence 'shortly.

(b) the manner in which funds P<sup>ro</sup>vided by Government to th<sub>e</sub> Cement Corporation of India for the above unit were utilised;

(c) what i<sub>s</sub> the capacity of the plant before take-over and after its takeover;

(d) whether all the units have been rehabilitated-

(e) if not, what ar<sub>e</sub> th<sub>e</sub> reasons for non-rehabilitating of the units; and

(f) whether there is any future planning in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI VIRBHADRA SINGH): (a) The Charkhi Dadri FacTory has produced 0.27 lakh tonne<sub>s</sub> of cement in 1981-82 and 1.23 lakh tonnes in 1982-83, upto February, 1983. Th<sub>e</sub> factory has made a provisional net profit o' Rs. 59 lakhs in 1982-83 upto February 1983 a<sub>s</sub> against a los<sub>s</sub> of Rs. 2 lakhs incurred in 1981-82.
