THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ARIF MOHD. KHAN): (a) The Coconut Development Board has already been constituted with 16 Members. The nomination of the remaining Members is under consideration.

(b) and (c) The Executive Committee can be constituted by the Board on the basis of the existing membership of the Coconut Development Board. Necessary directions have been given to the Chairman of the Board in this regard.
