AYA BHASKARA REDDY); (a) and (b) Of the 69 Indian Shipping Companies share of the two public sector companies, namely the Shipping Corporation of India and Mogul Line Ltd. in the national tonnage is 53.6 per cent. The first 9 private sector companies account for 33.67 per cent of the national tonnage. A statement I giving the details is furnished. (See below).
