As the honourable Members know, 3rd and 4th will be the Foreign Ministers' Conference and on the 5th and 6th, the Heads of States and Governments will start coming. The plenary session will start on the 7th. But, for the inaugural ceremony on the 7th, they have just made some arrangements for the Members of Parliament and details will be communicated by the respective Secretariats.
