tion. Really speaking, it was unpreparedness on the part of the Minister that he did not visualise or imagine that this could be a supplementary question. Now because of the fault of the hon. Minister, why should the right of any hon. Member be taken away? That day if he had come prepared and if he had given the reply, then the Member would have had a chance to put supplementaries...
