(a) what is the name of the contractor who was first given the contract to build the Talkatora Swimming Pool for the Asiad ;

(b) the date on which the first contract was given and whether the contractor who was first given, the contract on that date had completed the project; if not, what are the reasons therefor and what action was taken against him for breach of contract; and

(c) what is the expenditure incurred so far in building the said swimming pool ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SUPPLY AND OF THE DEPARTMENT OF

SPORTS (SHRI BUTA SINGH) : (a) and (b) The New Delhi Municipal Committee (NDMC), which has undertaken construction of the Talkatora Swimming Pool, awarded the civil and sanitary contract for the Swimming Pool to M/s CS. Atwal & Co. (Engineers) Pvt. Ltd., Calcutta. The contract was awarded on 28-10-1980. The same contractor is doing the work and has completed the work except for finishing touches at a few places.

(c) The NDMC has indicated that the expenditure incurred upto 27-10-1982 on the construction of the Swimming Pool was about Rs. 846 lakhs.
