

**Central projects in Jammu and Kashmir**

2316. SHRI DHARAM CHANDER : Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state :

(a) the number of Central development projects which are under construction in Jammu and Kashmir and the number of them which have been completed ;

(b) the total amount of expenditure incurred on them, separately; and

(c) the number of Central projects under construction in Jammu and Kashmir which are being executed by the State ?

THE MINISTER OF PLANNING (SHRI S.B. CHAVAN) : (a) As at the end of March, 1982, 16 Central Projects had been taken up in Jammu and Kashmir State of which 4 have been completed.

(b) The expenditure incurred on the different types of projects till the end of March 1982 is given below:—

This does not include expenditure figures on 2 projects while, in regard to 5 other projects, expenditure upto 31-3-81 only has been included.

**Group on disaster preparedness and management**

(b) if so, what are the recommendations made in the report of the Group;

(c) what are the reactions of various States thereon; and

(d) what are the details of the steps taken to mitigate public sufferings due to disasters ?

THE MINISTER OF PLANNING (SHRI S. B. CHAVAN): (a) Yes Sir. A Group on Disaster Preparedness and Management was set up by the Planning Commission in 1980 and its report was submitted to the Planning Commission in August 1981.
