(b) The estimated cost of each new cooperative spinning mill varies from Rs. 760 lakhs to Rs. 910 lakhs.

(c) 8 proposals—4 for organising new mills and 4 for expansion of the existing mills have been approved by the NCDC so far. The names of the mills are as follows:
