In accordance with the practices and usages customary among the bankers and also in conformity with the provisions of the statutes governing the public sector banks, information relating to financial assistance etc. given to individual constituent of the banks cannot be divulged.

# Review of law governing army personnel

\*137. SHRI JASWANT SINGH: SHRI SATYA PAL MALIK:

Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a proposal under Government's consideration to review the existing law governing the army personnel, in view of the recent observations made by the Supreme Court;
- (b) if so, what steps have been taken by Government in this regard; and
- (c) if the answer to part (a) above be in the negative, what are the reasons therefor?

OF DEFENCE THE MINISTER (SHRI R. VENKATARAMAN): to (c) In a recent judgement, on the petition Nos 4903 of 1981, 1513 1979 and 5930 of 1980 filed by three Army Officers, the Supreme Court have recommended (a) the setting up of a Court Martial Appeal Court and (b) Court Martial giving a speaking order in support of its verdict. Government propose to consult all concerned on this in the light of provision of Article 33 of the Constitution.

## Regimental Fund collected from N.C.C. cadets and officers

\*138. SHRI F. M. KHAN:

Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) the amount which the Directorate General N.C.C. had collected as

Regimental Fund from N.C.C. cadets and officers during the financial years 1980-81 and 1981-82, separately;

- (b) the amounts which were spent from the Fund on the Republic Day Parade Camps of 1981 and 1982 alongwith item of expenditure;
- (c) the amounts which were spent from the Fund on the items such as publication of periodical cadet journal, training books, presentations to VIPs and on entertaining guests and visitors to Directorate General N.C.C. during the years 1980-81 and 1981-82;
- (d) what are the other items alongwith amount, on which the Regimental Fund was spent during 1980-81 and 1981-82; and
- (e) what are the amounts from the Regimental Fund spent and balance at the end of each financial year?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI R. VENKATARAMAN): (a) to (e) The Dtc. Genl. NCC received Rs. 77,707.10 and Rs. 1,40,549 83 as its share of the NCC Regimental Fund during 1980-81 and 1981 82 respectively. (The amount for 1981-82 included some arrears for the past years.

Rs. 2,20,201.70 and Rs. 87,452.75 were spent from the said Fund on NCC Republic Day Camps during 1981 and 1982 respectively. The details of the items of expenditure are attached. (See below) The higher expenditure in 1981 was due to the fact that till and including 1981, part of the expenditure on the RD Campused to be met from the Regimental Fund of the NCC.

No amounts were spent from the Fund on publication of Cadet Journal, Training Books and presentation to VIPs during the above years. The expenditure on entertainment to guests and visitors to the Dte. Genl. NCC was Ro. 13,512 89 and Rs. 20,888.95 during 1980-81 and 1981-82 re-pectively.

The details of expenditure on other items by the Die, Genl, NCC from

the Regimental Fund during 1980-81 and 1981-82 are attached. (See below).

## News item "Hundreds that sail.

Will the Minister of FINANCE to plea ed to state:

- (a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news-item which appeared in the 'Statesman' of 14th August, 1982 under the caption "Hundreds that sail out in crores";
- (b) if so, what are the details in this regard;
- (a) whether an inquiry has been conducted into the smuggling activities; and
- (d) if so, what are the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI PATTABHI RAMA RAO): (a) Yes. Sir.

(b) The news-report mainly states that indian currency is being smuggled out of the country to Singapore, Hong Kong, and the Gulf countries during the recent months, and ottempts an analysis of the cause and effect of such smuggling.

(c) and (d) The matter has been inquired into. It is reported that there is some outflow of Indian currency through illicit channels mainly as a mode of payment for contraband goods smuggled into the country.

The concerned law enforcement agencies have been vigilant regarding this trend; and have been taking appropriate action to prevent such smuggling.
