

**Big Racket in Fake Degree and School Certificates**

@2276A. SHRI RAMKRISHNA MAZUMDER: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a big racket in fake degrees and school certificates has been detected by the Delhi Police, as referred to in the *Statesman* dated 8th July, 1982; and

(b) if so, what steps Government have taken in this regard and steps they propose to take to detect such rackets in future?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS AND DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI P. VENKATASUBBAIAH): (a) On receipt of a complaint about the genuineness of the certificates produced by three boys for seeking admission to the Delhi College of Engineering, a raid was conducted on the house of one Tej Kiran Jain, r/o Regharpura, Karol Bagh and a large number of unused certificates, mark sheets, rubber stamps, signatures and numbering blocks etc. were recovered.

(b) A case has been registered and 4 persons have been arrested.

As and when any specific information is received, prompt action is taken, in accordance with the law, in apprehending the culprits.

Arrangements have also been made with the suppliers of Colour TV parts to send their engineers to India during this period for giving necessary assistance and training to local TV industry. EITDC has also arranged for training of personnel at the manufacturing plants abroad.
