THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRIES OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI P. K. THUNGON): (a) The Hrjjfels "t A;arj':j pre in a good state of preservation after the removal of the varnish applied in 1921. The removal has revealed the original colours without any loss of pigments.

(b) and (c) Yes, Sir. Advice was sought from UNESCO experts who visited Ajanta and expressed their satisfaction on the preservation work, that are being carried out by the Archaeological Survey.

## Isdue of Liveries to class IV employees of Government aided schools in Delhi

- (d) whether equal amount of fund<sub>s</sub> <sup>are</sup> allocated to each of these schools for thi<sub>s</sub> purpose if not, what are the reason<sub>s</sub> therefor; and
- (e) what steps Government propose to take to remove discrimination in allocating funds to the aided schools in Delhi for the purpose?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRIES OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE AND SOCIAL WEL-

- FARE (SHRI P. K. TriUJNGON): (a) According to information furnished by the Delhi Administration, no such complaint has come to their notice. Liveries are issued by the Management concerned to ther Class IV employees.
- (b) Delhi Administration have issued instructions to all the aided schools to follow the procedure laid down by the Department of Personnel *L* A. R. in 'Hand book of Uniform of Class III and Class IV, employees'.
- (c) and (d) The amount s-^ent by management is re-imbursed as Per rules of grant-in-aid. The question of allocating a specified amount does not arise.
- (e) In view of reply to (c) & (d) above,, the question does not arise.

- (d) All such newly created posts are generally filled up in the month of September each year after completing all formalities.

This agreement has since been ratified by India and is expected to be ratified by Saudi Arabia soon. During the visit of Prime Minister to Saudi Arabia in April 1982, it was agreed that the first session of the Joint Commission would be held in India in October, 1982.
