(b) On the basis of the report of the Central Team and the recommendations of the High Level Committee on Relief thereon, the Government of India have sanctioned Rs. 4505.60 lakhs for flood relief during 1981-82. As regards drought which has been continuing after the monsoon of 1981, the Government of India have sanctioned a ceiling of expenditure of Rs. 39.53 crores up to March, 1982 and Rs: 37.03 crores up to September, 1982.

(c) The Government of Rajasthan have requested for further additional aid to meet the current drought situation. No decision has yet been taken.
