THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND **FAMILY WELFARE** (SHRI В SHANKARANAND): (a) No, Sir. The reserved posts for category I and II are filled up by candidates belonging to reserved categories except in cases where suitable candidates are hot available, in. which case the vacancies are carried forward to subsequent three recruitment years.

(b) Reserved Class III and*clas_s TV post_s are also invairiably filled with candidates belonging to the respec. tive reserved categories, subject to their availability.

(c) and (d) Non-availability of suitable candidates is the main reason for not filling up the vacancies by reserved category candidates.
