(b) what was the original estimate for this stage and what is the amount spent so far;

(c) whether it is a fact that work at this stage is suffering because of certain differences between Centre and the Rajasthan Government;

(d) if so, what is the nature of such differences;

(e) whether the same have been ironed out; and

(f) if not, what steps Government propose to take to resolve this dispute"

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION (SHRI Z. R. ANSARI).—(a) Out of 356 km. of main canal and 3,500 km.

of distribution system in Stage II of Rajasthan Canal Project, 133 km. of main canal and 180 km. of distribution system have been completed by March, 1982.

(b) As per 1970 project estimate, the cost of Stage II of the Project was Rs. 89.12 crores without price escalation. As reported by Rajasthan Government the revised cost of the Project is likely to be about Rs. 310 crores against which Rs. 102.20 crores have been spent upto March, 1982.
