Mass Awareness Campaign Through IT Yatras

346. DR. C. NARAYANA REDDY:

SHRI K. RAMA MOHANA RAO:

Will the Minister of INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact Government propose to launch a mass awareness campaign through IT Yatras;

(b) if so, the details of the proposal; and

(c) whether it would be successful with the present literacy rate of the masses?

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND MINISTER OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI PRAMOD MAHAJAN): (a) and (b) Ministry of Information Technology had set up a Working Group on IT for Masses which submitted its report on 29.07.2000. Towards mass campaign for IT awareness, the report recommends that IT Yatras should be launched under the leadership of prominent citizens/celebrities in different parts of the country and the Yatras to be conducted during the period 7th November, 2000 to 30th June, 2001 spread over three phases to be financed by the Central Government, State Government and industries equally.

(c) Literacy including computer literacy is useful to avail of the full benefits of Information Technology. However, the benefits of IT can be availed of by illiterates also, for example, by obtaining through Internet information on prevailing agricultural prices.
