(b) and (c) The efficiency of the Intelligence Bureau has not been impaired by such propaganda.

tions and a rally  $o_n$  23rd and 24th June, 1982 at Chandigarh, Government of Haryana had requisitioned Central forces to assist them in the maintenance of law and order. Some units of central forces were made available to the Government of Haryana. It is not in public interest to disclose the exact quantum of force made available to the State Government.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS AND DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI P. VEN-KATASUBBAIAH): (a) and (b) According to available information, the State-wise number of communal incidents which occurred in the country during the period from April 1981 to

May, 1982 i<sub>s</sub> as given in the statement attached. A total of 228 persons lost their lives, 3096 persons were injured and property worth about Rs. 1.68 crores was lost | damaged in these incidents. The information for the month of June, 1982 is not available.

- (c) Hyderabad and Medak in An-dhra Pradesh, Biharsharif and Sigori in Bihar, Ahmedabad, Baroda, Broach and Virangam in Gujarat, Bijapur, Chitradurga and Tiptur in Karnataka, Pune, Jalgaon, Akola, Solapu<sub>r</sub> and Malegaon in Maharashtra, Jodhpur and Siswali i<sub>n</sub> Rajasthan, Aligarh and Meerut in Uttar Pradesh, and Calcutta in West Bengal witnessed more than one communal incident during the year.
- (d) Information regarding the names of the places, if any, where communal incidents occurred during the year 1981-82 for the first time in the decade 1972-73 to 1981-82, is being ascertained and will be laid on the Table of the House.
- (e) The State Governments make exgratia payments as relief to sufferers in deserving cases, keeping in view the immediate needa and circumstances. The question of payment of compensation by Government does not arise.
