Fire in Warehouse in Madras Port

1441. SHRI M. KALYANASUNDARAM: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) the extent of loss to the Customs due to the fire accident to the bounded warehouse in Madras Port on the 7th June, 1982;

(b) what was the value of the properties bounded in that godown prior to the accident; and

(c) whether any enquiry has been made in the accident?

Institutional finance disbursed by Financing Institutions

1442. SHRIMATI KANAK MUKHERJEE: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) what are the details of the institutional finance authorised and disbursed by financing institutions as at the end of 1981-82, State-wise and region-wise;

(b) whether there is any regional imbalance in this regard; and

(c) if so, what are the factors responsible for the same?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI

JANARDHANA POOJARY): (a) The region-wise and State-wise details of financial assistance sanctioned and disbursed by the all-India term lending financial institutions viz., the Industrial Development Bank of India (IDBI), the Industrial Finance Corporation of India (IFCI) and the Industrial Credit and Investment Corporation of India (ICICI) as on 31-3-82 are given respectively in statements I, II and III.

(b) and (c) There is no regional bias in the matter of sanction or disbursal of assistance by the all-India term lending financial institutions, although there is some disparity in the quantum of assistance received by different regions from the institutions. The all India term lending financial institutions do not make any region-wise or State-wise allocation of funds for assistance to industrial units. Flow of assistance is essentially determined by locational decisions of the entrepreneurs. The locational decisions of the entrepreneurs depend on such important factors as availability of raw material, skilled labour, power supply, basic infrastructural facilities and proximity to market. Financial assistance is extended by the financial institutions in accordance with national priorities to all worthwhile projects which are found economically and financially viable and technically feasible. The ability of the financial institutions to sanction assistance to a particular region depends upon the number of viable proposals received from the region.
