REFERENCE TO THE PENSION PROBLEMS OF RETIRED RAILWAY EMPLOYEES

SHRI SUKOMAL SEN (West Bengal): Sir, I am mentioning an acute problem faced by the employees in the Railway Ministry after their retirement. The Railway Ministry says that the pension cases will be dealt with in the Finance Ministry and the Finance Ministry says that the Railway Ministry will be dealing with the pension cases of the railway employees. As a result, the railway employees are suffering after super-annuation, they are not getting pension.

Sir, a peculiar situation has arisen out of the problems of railway employees retired under SRPF. Sir, it is a matter of grave concern because of the way their problems are being tossed around from one Ministry to another without any solution. The Home Ministry says that the problems of railway pensioners are to be dealt with by the Railway Ministry and the Railway Ministry in turn advised the All India Retired Railwaymen's Federation that it was the Finance Ministry which was competent to deal with their problems

and the pension department of the Finance Ministry has again thrown the ball in the Railway Ministry's court. To say the least, this attitude speaks of utter callousness and indifference of the Government to their problems. This state of affairs has naturally created frustration among the pensioners. And the Government should know that most of the pensioners are facing a situation of destitution because of the nonchalant attitude of the Government.

Therefore, I urge upon the Government to examine their problems and redress them as early as possible.

श्री सुषम सिन्हा रज्जी (उत्तर प्रदेश) :
