For their stay in Delhi, pilgrims •will be required to make their own arrangements till their time of departure from Delhi under U.P. Government arrangements.

Further details of arrangements made will be supplied by post to those selected to undertake the pilgrimage.

Influx of foreigners visiting India during Asiad 82

 - (i) Eesides the existing 36 hotels with 3941 rooms in Delhi on the approved list of the Department of Tourism, 2196 additional rooms in II new hotels are expected to be commissioned in time for Asiad 1982.
 - (ii) In addition, 527 rooms (1200 beds) will also be made available in Ashok Yatri Niwas for the budget tourists, both domestic and international.
- (iii) The Delhi Tourism Develop-]-. ment Corporation is identifying pay-

ing guest accommodation besides setting up camping sites with tented accommodation to meet the overflow of tourists unable to get hotel accommodation.
