THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRIES OF INDUSTRY AND STEEL AND MINES (SHRI CHARANJIT CHANANA); (a) and (b) There was no scheme for import of cement against foreign exchange and hence the question of its revival does not arise. Prior to 28th February, 1982 import of cement was canalised through STC on Government account. With announcement of the policy on partial decontrol of cement, import of cement on Government account discontinued. Under the new policy of import of cement, the State Trading Corporation or any public sector agencies nominated by the State Governments! Union Territories can import cement on behalf of actual users.
