Since the road connecting Brahmavar and Shimoga is State road, Government of Karnataka is responsible for re-building the Barkur Bridge.

(a) whether it is a fact that Government have envisaged a National Highways Development Project-III; and

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise, particularly with reference to the State of Gujarat?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIAPPA): (a) and (b) Government has approved National Highways Development Project (NHDP) Phase-III consisting of stretches aggregating to 11113 km. of National Highways in the country Out of this, implementation of 4000 km. on BOT basis has been approved under NHDP Phase IIIA and preparation of Detailed Project Report for the remaining stretches. The stretches under this Phase have been identified as per the following criteria:

- (i) High density traffic corridors not included in Phases-I and II of NHDP.
- (ii) Providing connectivity of state capitals with NHDP (Phases-I & II).
- (iii) Connectivity of centers of tourism and places of economic importance.

The statewide details of stretches including State of Gujarat, identified under this Phase is enclosed as Statement.
