- (b) and (c) Railway is constantly pursuing the State Government and National Highways Authorities (NHAI) to sponsor proposals for construction of road overfunder bridges (ROB/RUBs) in fleu of busy level crossings (LC) by conducting regular meetings with them. Chief Secretary, Punjab Government has also been approached on the issue. NHAI has sponsored a few proposals viz:
 - i. Construction/Widening of four ROBs/RUBs on Jalendhar-Pathankot section
 - ii. Four on Jalandhar-Amritsar section
 - iii. Construction of four ROBs on Amritsar-Pethankot section-
 - iv. Construction of one ROB on Batala-Quadian section.
 - v. Work of ROB at Kurali on NH-21 is going on. Railway portion is likely to be completed by Dec., 2005.
 - vi: ROBs on Rapura bye pass on LC No. A-4/2 NH-64 on Patiala-Dhuri Section and on NH-1A at LC No. 78 Amritsar-Pathankot Section are also under consideration.

New train between Muzaffarnagar and Delhi

Karnaprayag railway line
